This proceeding was instituted under the Animal Welfare Act, as amended (7 U.S.C. § 2131 et seq.)(the "Act"), by a complaint filed by the Administrator, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, United States Department of Agriculture, alleging that the respondents willfully violated the Act and the regulations and standards issued thereunder (9 C.F.R. § 1.1 et seq.). This decision is entered into pursuant to the consent decision provisions of the Rules of Practice applicable to this proceeding (7 C.F.R. § 1.138).

Respondent American Furniture Warehouse, Inc., admits the jurisdictional allegations in the complaint, neither admits nor denies the remaining allegations, waives oral hearing and further procedure, and consents and agrees to the entry of this decision. The complainant agrees to the entry of this decision.

Findings of Fact

Respondent American Furniture Warehouse is a Colorado corporation whose registered agent for service of process is Jacob Jabs, 8820 American Way, Englewood, Colorado 80112. Between October 2002 and February 21, 2003, said respondent operated as an exhibitor as that term is defined

in the Act and the Regulations.

Conclusions

Respondent American Furniture Warehouse, Inc., has admitted the jurisdictional facts, the parties have agreed to the entry of this decision, and therefore such decision will be entered.

Order

1. Respondent, its agents and employees, successors and assigns, directly or through any corporate or other device, shall cease and desist from violating the Act and the Regulations and Standards.

2. Respondent American Furniture Warehouse is assessed a civil penalty of \$2,750.


This order shall become effective on the first day after service of this decision on the respondent. Copies of this decision shall be served upon the parties.


